During her time with award-winning menswear designer Antonio Azzuolo, she had the chance to design eyewear pieces for Warby Parker, sparking a newfound passion for eyewear. The more she explored the field, the more she fell in love with its shapes and materials. Driven by this passion, Selin became a full-time evewear designer and joined Warby Parker. Over two years, she created some of the company's most iconic and best-selling collections, many of which are still popular today. Inspired by her success, she founded her own eyewear design studio in New York City. Over the past nine years, Selin has collaborated with toptier clients across fashion, lifestyle, sports, and smart eyewear. She now lives in Brooklyn with her family, and her passion for her work remains as strong as when she first started in 2015.

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
